He received extensive training in new installations, rebuilds, restorations, tonal work, and service quality control. After completing the apprenticeship, he was awarded his service territory covering Virginia and North Carolina. This was the beginning of Thompson Pipe Organ, Co.

Thompson Pipe Organ Company is a full service company offering a wide variety of services to churches in Virginia and North Carolina. These services include annual tuning and maintenance, repairs, historical restoration, new additions, and rebuilding of organs. Re-leathering of all organ parts using the finest of leathers is done in the company's 4300 sq. ft. shop and warehouse located in Newport News, Virginia.



The company, in conjunction with R.A. Colby, also offers new, custom designed organs of the highest quality and craftsmanship with architectural style and quality to match any sanctuary. The new integrated solid state systems for consoles and electronic digital packages for organs give a complete and versatile system. The construction and design detail for new organs adheres to the highest standards while utilizing modern technology.

The company specializes in historical restoration, re-leathering and rebuilding of antique organs. Also complete rebuilding of American Classic organs such as Möller, Casavant, Austin, Reuter, Skinner, and others.

In 1999, Mark Thompson was proud to be part of the first ever Historic Organs Restoration and Conservation Colloquium sponsored by Colonial Williamsburg Foundation. The three day meeting was by invitation only and participation was limited to fifty organ specialists from around the world. 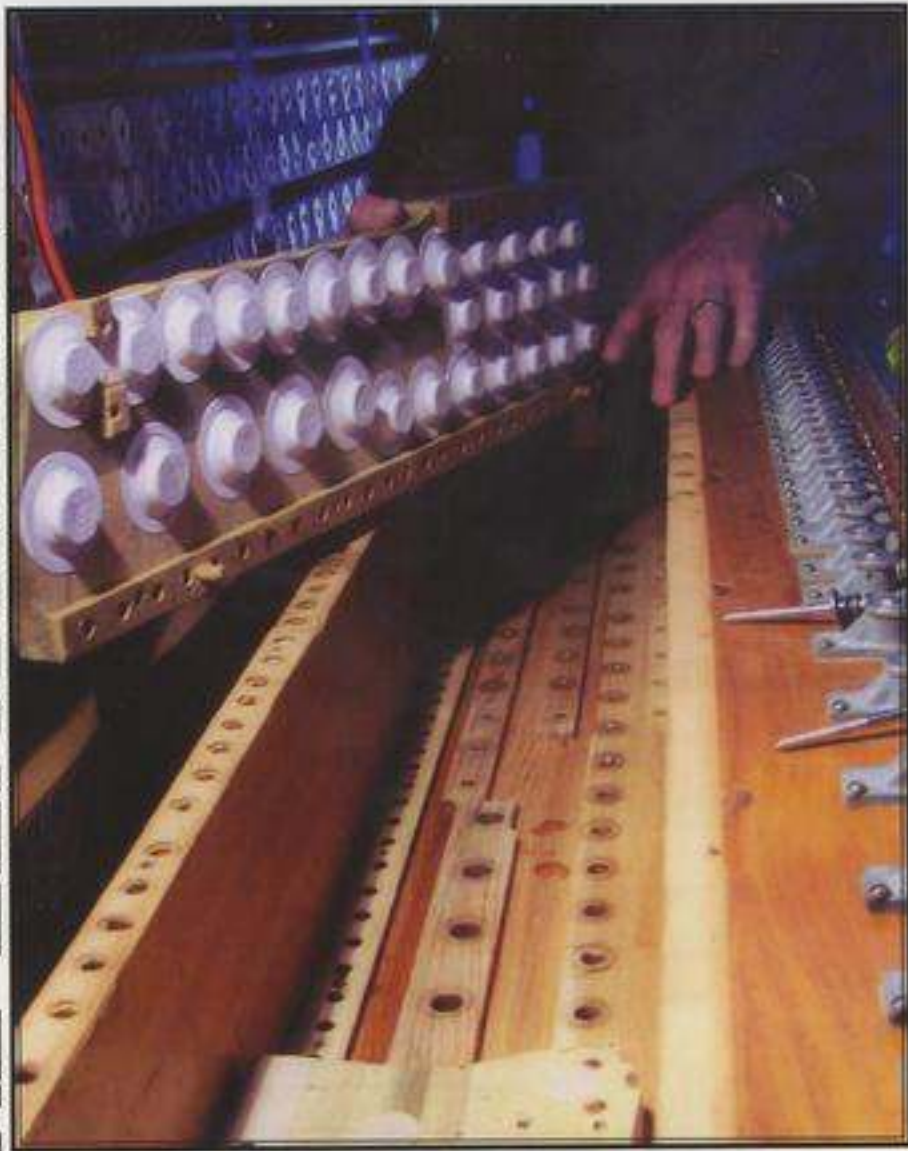

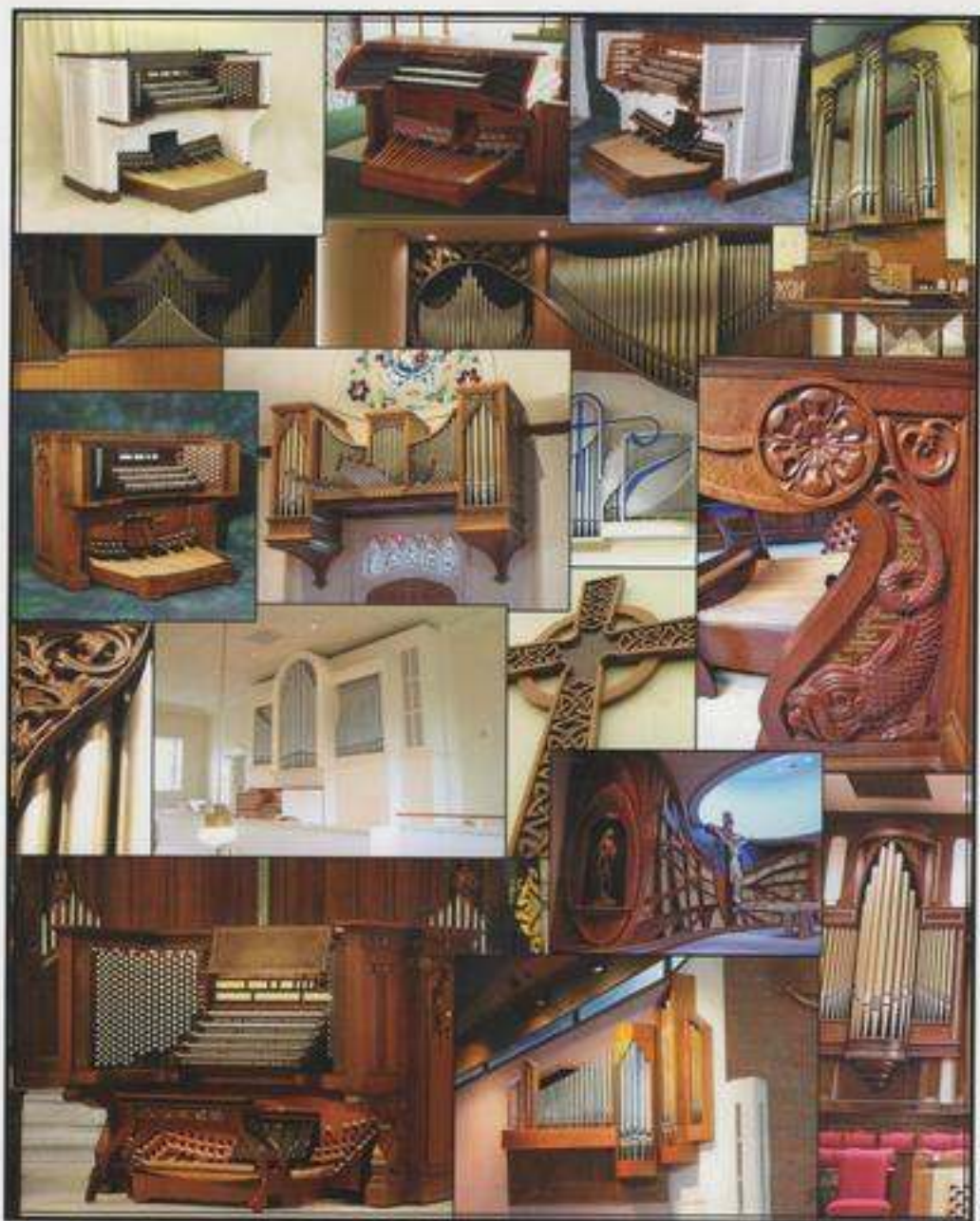
